“ I just heard the sad news today, a month after Celi’s death. How shocked am I! I grew up with Celi as the Mordarski’s were neighbors in the old Our Lady of Grace neighborhood until they left in the mid-60s.

I spoke of Celi and her brothers and sisters often through the years, but only a couple of times kept in contact. I remember so many stories of us walking to school together, attending church, and always remember when Celi would pull out the Michigan Catholic so we could see the rating (A, B, or C...condemned) of the movie we were going to see. I remember all the playing we did at both our homes and the time her dad fashioned a basketball hoop out of a hard cardboard barrel and hung it in the garage! And did we play basketball!

I remember a present she gave me for my birthday while we were in 7th grade. It was a purse! And I remember she said “It’s something you REALLY want”...and it was!

I remember playing down her basement where her mom had a “beauty parlor” set up. That’s where Celie and I first started experimenting with our hair color. Ever so slightly we lightened our color with, first, a rinse called “Noreen” where you diluted a little plastic capsule in a pint of water. Then on to other, stronger, chemicals to keep our hair blond as it darkened in our early teens.
