



Eddy Bullock Jr.

January 29, 1939 - January 13, 2025

It is with great sadness that we announce the passing of Eddy S. Bullock, Jr. on January 13, 2025, at the age of 85. Eddy was born on January 29, 1939, in Detroit, Michigan to Eddy S. (Sr.) and May (Stevenson) Bullock.

He graduated from Hazel Park High School in 1957 and then went on to attend Murray State University in Murray, Kentucky, majoring in Mathematics and minoring in Economics. Eddy spent most of his life living in the hometown that he loved, the City of Hazel Park. He married his beloved wife, Anna Bullock, in 1971, whom he affectionally called the "Silver Fox". They were married 53 years.

Eddy worked and retired as a Math Teacher (junior high and high school grade levels) for the Hazel Park School District. He also owned many different businesses throughout the years, including two (2) Dairy Queens located in southwest Detroit.

He was involved in local politics, on the Hazel Park Library Board, and over the years spent time volunteering with the Friends of the Hazel Park Library, Hazel Park Band Boosters, Packard Car Club, and various antique fire truck organizations across the state of Michigan. He owned and loved old cars and antique fire trucks. He always jumped at the chance to drive his 1947 Chevy Pumper Truck around town. You would spot him yearly in the Hazel Park

Memorial Day Parade and Frankenmuth Antique Fire Muster, until his health started to decline.

Eddy was known for his unique sense of humor, strong will, unwavering determination, and love and support for God, his family, police and fire departments, and community. In fact, his daughter lovingly gave him the legendary superhero status of the "Chuck Norris of All Dads" because he never met a stranger, would go out of his way to help anyone, was always working on something, and there wasn't anything that he couldn't fix.

Survived by: wife, Anna Bullock; daughter, Andrea "Andi" Courey (Michael); son, Eddy C. Bullock; granddaughter, Charley-Ann "Charley" Courey; sister-in-law, Linda Powers; granddogs, Marley and Pickles; and he is survived by several loving nieces, nephews, and cousins.
