Betty was a licensed practical nurse for many years, finishing her career in the pediatric unit at Oakwood Hospital in Dearborn in 1984. She cared for thousands of babies, including the children of several Detroit Tigers. During her latter years, Betty was thankful for the friendship and love she shared with the staff and residents of Mary's Center in Clinton Township. Throughout her life, Betty trusted in the goodness and mercy of the Lord Jesus Christ. Her vocation was one of simplicity, contentment, hugs, service to others, and an uplifting spirit.
