Fr. John was born in Chania, Crete, Greece on August 14, 1945, to Marinos and Athina Moutafis.

He married Presvytera Kassiani on October 6, 1968. Fr. John was Ordained a Greek Orthodox Deacon on December 12, 1985, and later Ordained a Greek Orthodox Priest on January 12, 1986. His greatest joy was performing Church Services, and he did so in countless Churches across many states. He was also a passionate and active member of the Pancretan Association. Fr. John's devotion to his family and his firm belief in God defined him. He was loved by his family and friends, and his joyful and warm demeanor will be greatly missed.
