Frank Tresnak, 67, of New Baltimore, MI, died January 27, 2021 in Ocala, FL.

Frank was born July 27, 1953 in Detroit, MI to Frank and Madoline (Cornell) Tresnak.

He graduated in 1971 from Lakeshore High School in St. Clair Shores, MI. He served in the United States Marine Corp 1972 to 1978.
