September 21, 1961 - May 17, 2021

Gregory Samuel Weihl, 59, of Haslett, Michigan passed away on May 17, 2021 from heart transplant complications. Greg was born in Dover, Delaware, on September 21, 1961 to Clinton G. and Ellyn C. (Hards) Weihl. As the son of a career Air Force officer, his childhood was spent on the move and in many places, living in France, Germany and Canada as well as Delaware, Alabama, Texas, New Jersey, California, North Carolina, and his home state of Michigan.

Greg was a proud and loving father to his son and daughter, as well as their significant others and any other honorary kids that came into his life. There were few things he loved more than enjoying good weather with loved ones, especially paired with good music, good food and good grog, so he very rarely missed a Blissfest. He was a beloved member of his online gaming community, and part of an ongoing, decades-long tabletop campaign with old friends. He greatly appreciated the expert care provided by the team at the University of Michigan Cardiovascular Center in the latter part of his life, and was able to continue living independently after receiving an LVAD in 2016.

Greg is survived and missed by his daughter Cathryn (Christopher Paterson) Weihl of Charlotte, North Carolina, his son Eric Weihl of Troy, Michigan, his brother Jeffrey (Elizabeth) Weihl of Holt, Michigan and countless loved ones including his niece, nephew, uncle and cousins, his former spouses, step-children and in-laws, and a great many dear friends.

Greg was preceded in death by his parents, Clint and Ellyn Weihl, as well as his grandparents, aunts, and other loved ones.
