From there he moved to Painter and Ruthenberg Hauling, where he was the Operations Manager. It was from here, he finally retired. Guy was a long time, active sponsor for Alcoholics Anonymous for over 41 years. He was a strong and positive influence for many that he sponsored.

Guy and Amal enjoyed retirement by splitting their time between their homes in Detroit, & Grayling, MI and Fort Myers, FL. As snowbirds, for 25 years, Guy was very active in the Fountain View Park Community. He held board positions and headed up countless activities for the park.
