On May 6, 2024, Hipolito V. Ylen, endeared by many as “Lito” entered eternal life with his Creator.

Born in Quezon City, Philippines in 1945, Lito conquered both sea and land. Before “startups” became common phrase, he co-founded and led two tech companies in the Philippines with fellow IBM colleagues. He was an avid golfer and had a passion for fishing. He earned recognition as Philippine Angler of the Year in '95 and was president of the Philippine Game Fishing association in the 90s. He reached for even greater heights as an active member of the Ayala Mountaineering Club. He loved the outdoors, but when he wasn't conquering seas and mountains, he was just as comfortable indoors, in the kitchen. From brulées to puttanesca, steaks to sukiyaki, sushi, and sashimi, his kitchen vocabulary was extensive with dishes that spanned many cultures and formats.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Isidro and Patricia Ylen, his first wife Miring Garcia Ylen, and his step-children, Ryan and Jennifer Ambrosio.
