Jadwiga Pavlak Born: September 24, 1921 in Potarzyca, Poland. Beloved daughter of the late Franciszek and Franciszka Budziak (nee: Marciniak). Beloved wife of the late Frank Pavlak; who were married on September 15, 1940 in Korbia, Poland. Due to WWII, mom and dad were separated for 16 1/2 years. They were finally reunited in February 1958 when mom immigrated to the USA. In 1990 they returned to Poland to celebrate their 50th wedding anniversary. They lived nearly 40 years in East Detroit and in their later years moved to Warren. She enjoyed being a homemaker, loved gardening and her grandchildren. Her last 2 1/2 years were spent in Connecticut. She leaves behind a daughter Mary Charland and son-in-law Richard Charland Jr. of Norwich, CT; and a son Richard Pavlak of Warren; four grandchildren and four great grandchildren. Two daughters and one son predeceased her during the war years. Mrs. Pavlak is predeceased by 3 brothers, two in Poland and one Germany she also predeceased by her 3 sisters all of Poland. She leaves behind one surviving sister and sister-in-law in Poland and many, many nieces and nephews.
