He and John enjoyed going to the annual Twinsburg Festival in Ohio, which was a gathering of twins, triplets etc. He enjoyed vacationing at the family cottage, trips to Kentucky, Myrtle Beach Apert gatherings and most recently an Alaskan cruise. His first time out of the

state was the annual road trip to New Mexico in the 70's. Being the committed runner he was, he always made sure to get his runs in even on vacation, which meant being let out on the side of the road and running 3-5 miles to catch up with us as we waited for him. Loving grandfather of Amy James (Taylor Perreault), Sara Canada, James Bayagich and Lucas Bayagich. He never missed a hockey, baseball or soccer game that his grandsons played. 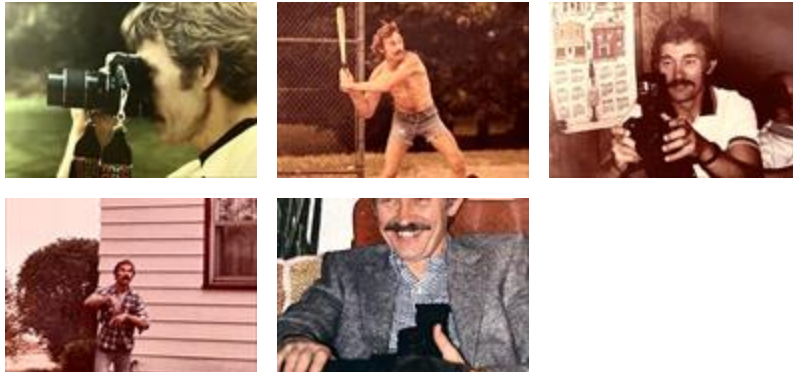
