Age 95, passed away February 7, 2018. Dear wife of the late Anthony.

Jennie's maiden name was Wojcik. Her father Walter Wojcik helped start the All Saints congregation of the Polish National Catholic Church in Detroit in the 1920's. Her mother Felicja Wojcik was deeply involved in a Polish women's society. After graduating from Denby High School in Detroit, Jennie was tutored in advanced sewing. During World II, Jennie working in a factory that made parts for the war effort. Wed in 1942, Jennie was married to Anthony for 37 years, until his death in 1979. After the war, Jennie became a homemaker and mother to two daughters, Janis and Jolyn. Jennie made all of her daughters' clothes, including their wedding dresses when the times came for them to marry. Jennie was always active at home, keeping large gardens, landscaping, making ceramics, sewing, crocheting, and even painting the house inside and out when her husband worked long hours as a tool and die worker. Jennie was a long-time, devoted member of the All Saints parish, often helping make pierogi and donating hand-made afghans for church fund raiser. Until her death at age 95, Jennie lived independently in the house that she and Anthony built in Harper Woods in 1953. She lived there by herself 38

years as a widow. If you ask her family about Jennie, three things stand out: her independent spirit, her sense of humor, and her generosity. In her last years and days, she remained creative and sharp of mind, even finding multiple ways to make her home more livable for her as her mobility seriously decreased. She was a strong, independent, humorous, caring, creative, and generous woman. She will be missed.
