

## Julian P Baranowski

November 12, 1929 - August 17, 2019

Julian P. Baranowski, at age 90, passed into eternal rest on August 17, 2019. He is survived by his wife Zofia, his children, Michael, John, and Julie and their spouses, Margaret, Kaye and Joseph. He is the son of Joseph and Rosalia Baranowski and the brother to: Frank Baranowski, Zigmund Baranowski and Casmira Miga. Julian is survived by his 12 grandchildren: Nicholas, Jessica, Matthew, Gabrielle, Theresa, Grace, Joseph, Natalie, Isabel, Andrew, Ryan and Daniel.

Julian was born in Poland and immigrated to the United States with his family, but their journey was not direct. He and his family were taken by force to labor camps in Siberia during World War II. They survived the camps and traveled across Asia to India, where they got passage to the United States.

He is an alumnus of Orchard Lake St. Mary's Preparatory School and the University of Detroit, obtaining a degree in mechanical engineering. Julian served most of his career as an engineer for General Motors. He also served in the community, sitting on the board of directors of a local credit union for many years and always being willing to help friends and family with repairs to their cars.

Julian met his wife during his college years through the local Polish community. She had also immigrated to the US after the war. They were

married and built a house in Warren, MI, where he lived until his passing. However, his home away from home was his cottage in Port Austin, Michigan. It was his “Shangri la” as he called it.

No matter where Julian went, he would leave a legacy, through his never-ending hospitality, his incredible work ethic, his love for his friends, and above all for the way he loved and provided for his family. He will be missed, but never forgotten.

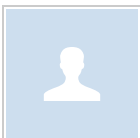
