Kirk Douglas Phillips, Age 65, passed away at home on December 31, 2020 after a courageous battle with cancer. Kirk was born on April 27, 1955 in Highland Park, Michigan and resided in Warren at the time of his death. 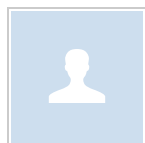

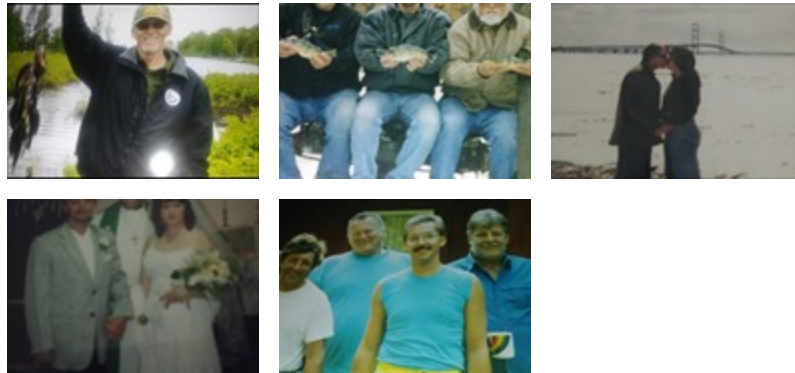
