Age 86, of Naples, Florida, formerly of Michigan, passed peacefully in his sleep surrounded by his family.

He was born on May 6, 1931 in Kerrobert, Saskatchewan, Canada to the late Lyall J. and Sarah M. Haynes (Lehman).

Larry started his early twenties by enlisting in the United States Army in May of 1949 to fight in the Korean War in the 17th Infantry Regiment 7th Division. He fought hard for his country and earned many medals and awards such as Combat Infantry's Badge, Bronze Star with four battle stars, Korean Presidential Unit Citation, Korean Service Medal, and Good Conduct Medal, but was most proud of the Purple Heart he was awarded. He came back to the United States in 1951 and was promoted to First Sergeant where he patrolled Indianapolis, Columbus, and Franklin, Indiana as military police. After he got out of the service in 1952, he married his high school sweetheart, Evelyn Bouchard and started his family of all boys. He went to Trade School and worked as a sheet metal journeyman for Sheet Metal Workers Local 80 until his retirement in 1987.

He moved to Florida with his wife where they enjoyed golfing, playing cards, and socializing with many family and friends. He enjoyed custom making fishing rods, which he gave to many family and friends, and even sold some
