Marina D. Angco, 79, died on Monday, July 8, 2019 at William Beaumont Hospital in Troy with her granddaughter, Jane, by her side.

Born on June 18, 1940 in the Philippines to Andres Dollolasa and Rosita Torrico Dollolasa, she married the love of her life, Antonio Angco on February 11, 1969 in the Philippines.

Marina made the move to the United States in 1971 in search for a better life. Once established in Detroit, MI, Marina's husband and young daughter followed Marina to Michigan. Marina worked as a registered nurse working primarily at Oakland General Hospital. Once established in the U.S., they soon welcomed their second child, Jeffrey.

Marina was an active member of St. Jane Francis de Chantal Catholic Church for over 40 years, and received the sacrament to Reconciliation and attended mass for the final time the night before her death.
