Martin Pakledinaz, Tony Award-winning costume designer, died peacefully in his Manhattan apartment Sunday, July 8th, surrounded by friends and family. He was 58. He was born on September 1st, 1953 to James Pakledinaz and Dorothy (Haight) Pakledinaz. He grew up in Sterling Heights, Michigan and is survived by six brothers and his sister, nine nieces and nephews, and three godchildren. His love of theatre started at age 13 when he volunteered with the Macomb County Community Players at the Barn Theatre. He won his first Tony Award for the 1999 production of "Kiss Me Kate", and his second for 2002's "Thoroughly Modern Millie".
