Michael Thomas Rathsburg, age 80, passed away on March 16, 2026. Born to Anna A. Danculovich and John M. Rathsburg, Michael was married to Deborah Mary (Nee Weber) Rathsburg for 50 years this June. He is proudly survived by his two sons, Kyle Michael (Kathryn) and Jay John (Kellee) and his two precious grandsons Jack Montgomery and Dean Kelly. “Big Mike” was the 10th of 11 children, preceded in death by siblings Mary E. (William) Trampus, Patricia A. (Robert) Johnston, John M. (Marceline), and Judith C. (Richard) Jarvis. He is survived by five remaining siblings, William J. (Sherry deceased), Susanne A. United States Navy Torpedoman's Mate Third Class (E-4) Rathsburg then actively served our United States Navy for four years and continued on for many years in the Naval reserves; he was a life-time member and serving Commander of Amvets Post 27; and spliced cable for Michigan Bell for 28+ years. Hunting deer, shooting turkey/pheasant, fishing for salmon, training his master hunting Labrador retriever, actively

working at the Huron River Labrador Retriever Club, driving his precious trucks, loving his furry friends Sugar Bear, Hawk, Missy, Mac, Bear, and Lily, cheering for his Detroit Red Wings and Lions, and pulling his luxury campers were what he enjoyed most in retirement. Mike diligently worked his AA program and recently celebrated 41 years of sobriety. He is treasured and will be missed by many!!!
