Miguel Angel (Mike) Rosado died peacefully and went to be with the Lord on Friday, April 23, 2021, at Troy Beaumont Hospice after a short illness. He was born on June 22, 1950 in the Bronx, New York. He joined the U.S. Navy after high school graduation and was proud to serve his country. 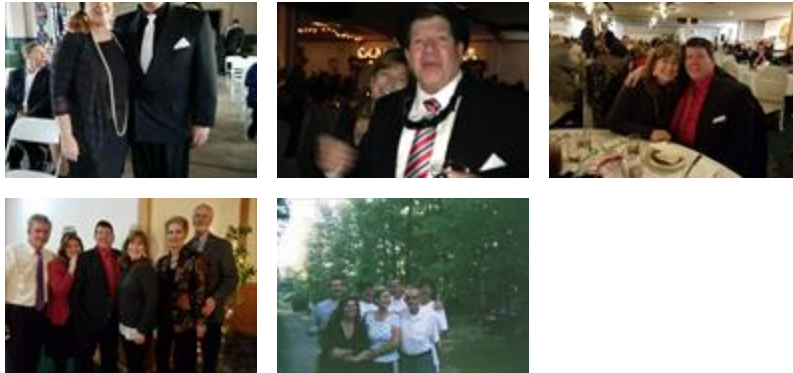

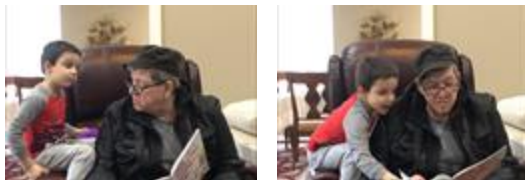
