Whenever anyone needed a volunteer, she was the first to raise her hand whether it was serving on the vestry at church, baking cookies for a bake sale, or bringing dinner and friendship to others through Meals on Wheels. She was known for her laugh and enjoyed swapping stories with the golfers while working as a ranger at the course.

Nancy is survived by her children, Charles (Janet), Jill (David), Dean (Penny), and Brett (Lori). She was affectionately known as MooMoo by her grandchildren, Carl (Colleen), Glen, Paul (Jacqueline), Keenan, MacLean, Harrison, William, Jacob, Mitchell, Justin, AJ, Samantha, and Carlin, and great-grandchildren Waylen, Shiloh, Selah, Rhett, and Juliet.

She is preceded in death by her sisters, Carlin Alexander and Laurel Witten.
