“ Heartfelt condolences go out to Mike Powell and Cheryl, Kaitlin and Patrick Donovan in Florida (Paulette's younger sister) on the passing of Paulette Powell. She sure spread a lot of love in her 70 short years and the world feels a little smaller and lonelier without our family's beloved "Pauldy."

Gotta say, growing up in Hazel Park and Warren, Mich., in the 1970s, my father Hank was 15th of 16 siblings so the "Skoczylas" Polish clan always seemed to overwhelm the presence of Paulette / Cheryl / Mother Virginia Wojnarski wing of the families. Yet, my mother Dorothy, Aunt Virginia came from a family of 9 total Lewandowski siblings all the same.

A couple memories to share:

-- When Paulette and Mike first got married back around 1977, maybe, their wedding reception was actually in Hank and Dorothy's back-yard in Warren. Hank's house was located on a curve, creating a back-yard with a curve, and a total of about 1/4-acre of backyard space. Paulette and Mike's wedding reception was well attended that they got sent off on their beautiful life together in a fine fashion.

-- Decades later, when my mother Dorothy passed away in 2003, Paulette sang "Ave Maria" inside the church at St. Martin de Porres Catholic Church in Warren and it was as moving a rendition of that great spiritual song, for me and my brothers Larry and Bob, and our father, Hank, who was still alive then, when Paulette belted out "Ave Maria" and in echoing Paulette's similar performance for Aunt Wantda (nice salute from Cathy Cesulski here online about that, I hear you cousin-Cathy).

-- Speaking of the wonderful Walter & Wanda Cesulski family in Madison Hts., it may not be known that Paulette's last job as Senior Accountant for a local auto supplier put her a 2-minute-drive away from the Cesulski household there on Miracle Drive in Mad Hts., Paulette was able to look in on Walter in his aging and declining years on an almost daily basis, giving comfort and security to the extended Cesulski sibilings including aforementioned Cathy, Chris and Paul, whom we all grew up with. Paulette looking in on Wally almost every day for a couple of years there was an incredible act of kindness and love and spoke well of her endlessly generous heart

and sharp-eye for filling life's needs and family's needs without being ordered or asked to participate. It was an act of love on Paulette's part, not a labor.

Finally, I gotta remind everyone that when I was baptized at St. Florian Catholic Church in Hamtramck, Mich., back in August of 1958, when I was 8 months old (born in Dec., 1957), that my spiritual Catholic godfather was Paulette's father, Eugene, and Paulette's aunt, Wanda Cesulski (Walter's wife and my Mom's sister), was my spiritual Godmother, too.'

Score this Love Letter to Paulette as an endorsement for what the Lewandowski / Wojnarski side of our extended family contributed to my own life and career and all.

Thank you, Paulette, for spreaing all that glorious love you did in your 70 busy years and your extended, Polish-Catholic family thanks you here in public for all that you GAVE in life to the rest of US.
