I hit send, he picked up the phone, He said to me "my father just died, collapsed at the driving range". What?..... I'm confused. I was thinking that Pranav was having some sort of recollection replay issue with time, as his beloved father and hero passed on just months earlier. Memories of my aunt in the early eighties telling my mother that JFK had just been shot quickly ran through my mind, which of course happened November 1963. What????.... absolute best person, some years after they are settled?" P "OK, that would be good".
