Ronald Marr Taylor, age 73, of Sterling Heights, MI passed away on September 19, 2022. He was born in Toronto, Ontario to the late Frederick & Bernice (Marshman) Taylor. His family moved to the United States when Ron was 3 years old.

Ron and Patti were married in 1969 -- Ron received his draft notice two weeks before the wedding and left for the Army two weeks after. He was fortunate to be stationed in Anchorage, Alaska, where Patti was able to follow and where they welcomed their first child. When he was discharged, Ron and Patti bought a home in Hazel Park and lived there for 18 years, raising their two children, Tina and Kenny, before moving to Sterling Heights, where they currently reside.

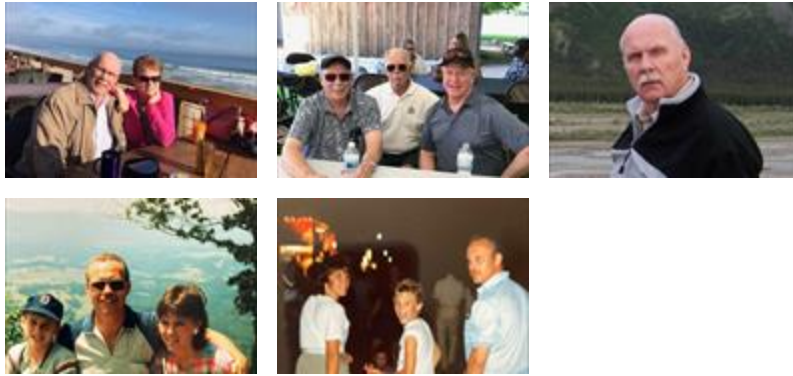
