March 13, 1948 - November 23, 2020

Ronald Edgar Tucker was born March 13, 1948 in Detroit, Michigan. He lost his battle with Covid-19 on Monday, November 23, 2020 after a valiant 13 day fight to survive.

Ron grew up in Ferndale, Michigan, graduated from Ferndale High School in 1966 and was drafted in to the US Army in August of 1967. His advanced training was in the Signal Corp and he was sent to Vietnam in April 1968 as a Radio Relay and Carrier Operator. He was honorably discharged April 13, 1969.

Ron was a much loved husband, father, papa, brother, brother-in-law, uncle , great uncle and friend. He is survived by his wife of 53 years, Michele; his daughters, Jennifer (Gino) Minchella and Angela (Al) Lenz, as well as his six grandchildren Gabrielle Minchella, Desiree Minchella, Dominic Minchella, Cheyenne Lenz, Cienna Lenz, Ciara Lenz and his sister, Linda Littlejohn. He is preceded by his daughter, Amy; his mother, Grace Elwart; his father, Edgar Tucker; as well as his mother-in-law Lucille Redden; sister-in-law Pat Gallagher and brother-in laws Dennis Gallagher and Bert Littlejohn.
