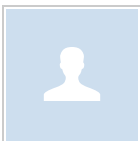

“ I met Sue while working at Deloitte & Touche. She went to college at Western Michigan University and was recruited to work in the Chicago D & T office. She grew up in Michigan and decided to transfer to the Detroit office so she could be back in Michigan closer to her family. I met her in the Ren Cen office on her first week in Detroit when they had an informal staff luncheon with about 20 young staffers with a few Partners as a mixer. She was introduced to the group as a transfer to our office and I talked to her after the luncheon. I called her a few days later and invited her to dinner because she was new in town and I felt like that would be a nice thing to do since she didn't know anyone. My audit team all teased me that she would get the wrong impression that it was a date, but it was the start of a wonderful friendship.

I invited Sue to do things with my friends, including Mike and Andrea Keller Fluent. We were in the Rochester Jaycees together and she would go on bike rides with us in our glory days when we would just ride and ride bikes for miles and do different bike rides around the state of Michigan. Those were fun times with our friends! Mike and his brothers met Frank years before doing the WAM Bike Ride through Make-A-Wish. Sue met Frank at Stony Creek when we were riding bikes. We all went to watch a bike race that Frank told us about in Rochester and he asked Sue out on a date. They were engaged after 8 months and were married 20 years ago in November 1996, the same year as Mike and I. I remember they both had planned major trips before they were engaged and they had to plan and coordinate the details of their trips along with their wedding. Frank went to the Tour de France and Sue went to the Olympics in Atlanta the summer before their wedding. She did a reading at our wedding and I was a bridesmaid in their wedding. We planned our weddings together and were pregnant together for our first babies....but Sue and Frank went on to have a large family of 6. Frank went to his 30th class reunion at Bishop Foley a week after his youngest son Dominic was born. Frank laughed when he told us that they had an award for the first grandparents at the reunion and he got the award for having the youngest child.

We saw each other often when the kids were young and they attended St Lawrence Church. The Scarchilli's became home-schoolers when Emilie started school and eventually transferred to SS. Cyril and Methodius Church. They are involved in their large home-schooling co-op for group classes like art and gym and where mothers teach different subjects and swap with other mothers. I had heard recently that Sue was coordinating the home-school group.

Sue was also very active in the Pro-Life movement and was the leader of the group at St Lawrence for many years before they transferred over to SS Cyril & Methodius.

When our boys were young in Cub Scouts, Frank asked Mike and Joe Lograsso if their Home-Schooling group could race cars with the St Lawrence Cub Scouts so they attended a few of our Pinewood Derby races. Their oldest son, Frankie, also played baseball with the Mustangs for a few years so I always loved to see the Scarchilli's when our games would overlap at St Lawrence.

Please pray for Sue and Frank and their children as they prepare to celebrate and honor Sue's life with her family and many devoted friends. She has left an incredible legacy!

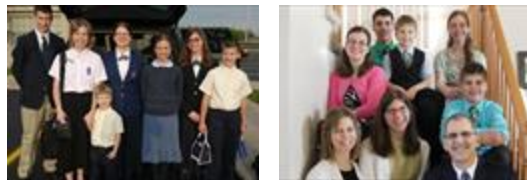
