*God Bless and treasure your spirit in His everlasting Home.*

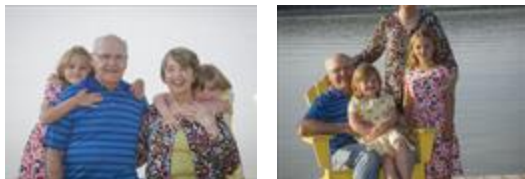
