You shared your love in every aspect of your life even as a patient....

He took you as a broken vessel as a child and used you for blessing others. You were healed and you let the world know . He used you even later in life in a wheelchair to reach out to others and be joyful.

You also had a fighting Spirit about you for the underdog. How you can be such an advocate to try and make things right and watch out! The funny thing is you never spoke up for yourself; you had a selflessness about you.

And oh my how you love the babies! Honestly I don't think we could have given you enough grandkids in the world! You always made all children your grandkids.

I remember when Kristian was little and you would pull up in the driveway and he would say "Busia's home!" It was so cute, even though you didn't live with us. Well, little did I know that this is how I feel as you have left earth to be in heaven. You are home in my heart; we all carry you in our hearts.

Mom, you gave so much more than you ever took. You never lost your joy; you did not have an easy life, but you rarely complained.

In spite of your struggles, afflictions, actions of others who have made life difficult for you, you remained positive and strong.

You are by far one of the richest people I know. The wealth of love and people that's around you; from childhood friends to caretakers late in life; they All loved you. They were drawn to your light.

I'm so blessed to call you Mom but most of all to call you friend. I will miss you and our deep conversations. I will miss playing games with you. I have no more reason to rush out of work to visit and check on you. I love you Mom and will see you in heaven.
