It is with heavy hearts that we announce the passing of Thomas (Tom) Robert Mally, age 49, of Beverly Hills, Michigan. He departed this world peacefully on March 19, 2024 with Sarah, his beloved wife of 10 years, at his side. Tom was surrounded by loved ones after a hard-fought battle with Diffuse Large B-Cell Lymphoma.

Born on December 3, 1974 in Detroit, Michigan to Irena and Roman, Tom grew up in Sterling Heights, Michigan and spent part of his youth in Poznan, Poland.

After graduating from Lawrence Technological University with a bachelor's degree in Mechanical Engineering, Tom devoted his entire career to Nissan where he succeeded to the position of Director. He cultivated many of his dearest friendships throughout his nearly 27 years with the company.

In 2008, Tom met the love of his life, Sarah, and they married in 2013. They shared many interests, including live music, real estate, and motorcycles. Together they traveled the world, and spent time living in the US, Japan, and Mexico, and welcomed a beloved son in each of those countries.

Tom is survived by Sarah and his treasured sons, Lukasz (9), Jakub (7), and Daniel (5). He was immensely proud of his boys and they will cherish his

He touched the lives of many with his leadership and was known for being tough but fair. Tom will be remembered as a person of strong conviction. He was thoughtful, practical and logical, while also quite comfortable as the life of the party, with a great sense of humor and kindness.

He will be deeply missed by his sister, Kasia (Frenkli), sister-in-law Jenn (John), brother-in-law Adom (former spouse, Traci), Goddaughter Nicole, niece Kayla, Goddaughter and niece Adriana, nephews Connor, Tristan, JT, Jackson, and Mateo, mother-in-law Katherine, father-in-law Michael, Ciocia Danuta, Aunt Barbara, cousins, and countless friends and colleagues who were fortunate enough to know him.
