Walter had an illustrious career as a political journalist for a multitude of international Ukrainian newspapers, including 20 yrs at "Svoboda" in Jersey City, NJ. He spoke several languages and used his linguistic skills to translate political events from the New York Times, Wall Street Journal and other American papers.

After moving to Detroit to be nearer to his only daughter, he served on the Board of Directors of the Ukrainian Cultural Center in Warren. He was also very active in many Ukrainian organizations and wrote as a freelance writer well into his mid eighties. Walter was a frequent speaker at many events in the Warren Ukrainian Community.

He is survived by his daughter Mira and husband Yaroslav Stakhiv along with his grandsons Stephen, Mark & Daniel.
