Later, William became an avid golfer and bowler, where his natural abilities won him great recognition. William was a graduate architect and member of Christ Episcopal Church in Grosse Pointe. Because of his outstanding architectural and design skills, in 1996 he was asked by the Rector of Christ Church to design, plan and direct the construction and completion of the first major addition to the church since its founding in 1929. William also created - and was the first chairperson - of the Gifts and Acquisitions Committee for Christ Church. William's keen and long-term vision for this important body has continued to provide significant gifts, including stained glass windows and the refurbishing of multiple art and furnishing projects. Recently, William joined the RCIA program at SS. Cyril and Methodius and was entering the Catholic faith. William enjoyed the outdoors, gardening and absolutely loved canoeing and fishing in the Au Sable River. William loved to cook and entertain for his family and friends. It was important to him that he have dinner with his family every night at their dining room table. William is survived by his beautiful wife, Pat, his 3 kids, Warren, Sean and Renee and his stepchildren, Jim (Brie) and Jaclyn. William was selfless, compassionate and caring and will be so missed by everyone that knew him. Visitation will be Tuesday from 3:00pm until 9:00pm with a 7:00pm Rosary service.
