William's keen and long-term vision for this important body has continued to provide significant gifts, including stained glass windows and the refurbishing of multiple art and furnishing projects. Recently, William joined the RCIA program at SS. Cyril and Methodius and was entering the Catholic faith. William enjoyed the outdoors, gardening and absolutely loved canoeing and fishing in the Au Sable River. William loved to cook and entertain for his family and friends. It was important to him that he have dinner with his family every night at their dining room table. William is survived by his beautiful wife, Pat, his 3 kids, Warren, Sean and Renee and his stepchildren, Jim (Brie) and Jaclyn.
